“How many times were South Australia Police called to Flinders Medical Centre, Noarlunga Hospital, Royal Adelaide Hospital, Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Modbury Hospital, Lyell McEwin Hospital and the Women's and Children's Hospital respectively in 2023 and to date in 2024.”

The below figures illustrate the number of South Australian Computer Aided Dispatch (SACAD) events created for Police attendance at Flinders Medical Centre (FMC), Noarlunga Hospital, Royal Adelaide Hospital, Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Modbury Hospital, Lyell McEwin Hospital (LMH) and Women’s and Children’s Hospital (WCH) for the 2023 calendar year and the 2024 calendar year-to-date.

The figures provided are inclusive of SACAD events created relative to calls for police assistance to ‘000’ and ‘131444’ as well as SACAD events created by Police attending at the location in the execution of their duties. It is not possible to accurately distinguish between the two.
