Re: Freedom of Information Act application

In reference to your application made pursuant to the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), access was sought to:

"Number of assaults and serious assaults in every SA prison, split into each site, across the previous five financial years. The assault numbers should include assaults by a prisoner against another prisoner and prisoner against prison officers"

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located information that falls within the scope of your request and agree to *release this information to you in full*.

Offence data was extracted from SAPOL's Shield database utilising Business Objects, Data Warehouse searches as well as manual data analysis and categorisation.

The definition of 'serious offence' was taken from Australian and New Zealand Standard Offence Classification (ANZSOC) which includes certain classifications of employment and vulnerability.
